

Palmyra Public Library Wireless Network Policy

Palmyra Public Library's wireless network is free and available to the general public and adheres to all the terms and conditions set forth in the Lebanon County Library System's Public Computer Use Policy.

No special passwords are needed to access the wireless network. Patrons are expected to know how to configure their laptop or wireless devices for wireless use. The library does not offer wireless access support. A document with technical details on configuring your operating system for wireless access is available at the circulation desk or through the library web site.

Palmyra Public Library can not be responsible for any changes you make to your computer's or device's settings, nor will we help you configure your computer. If you need assistance, contact the manufacturer for your hardware or software.

Palmyra Public Library does not provide encryption or other security features for its free wireless service. So, patrons assume all risks and responsibilities to provide anti-virus protection and appropriate security settings on their laptop or wireless devices.

Most wireless equipment will be compatible. However, the Palmyra Public Library makes no guarantees as the compatibility of our equipment.

Printers are NOT available to wireless users in the library, you may download documents to disk or e-mail them to your own account and print them from the library public access computers. The public access computers are available during normal library business hours and shut down fifteen minutes prior to the library's closing.

Patrons should be certain that their laptops or other wireless devices are secured at all times and should never be left unattended in the library, even for brief periods. Palmyra Public Library is not responsible for stolen property.
