

## Library **Kindle** Books Downloading **USB Transfer**

(for Penguin books or if WiFi is not available)

**If you are borrowing a Penguin title or if you do not have access to WiFi, simply follow these steps to load the book onto your Kindle device.**

- Select a book from eLibrary
- Select *Kindle* format
  - **Note about Penguin books:** at this point, you will know if you are choosing a Penguin book title by looking at the format instructions. If the instructions say for Kindle via USB transfer only, then you have chosen a Penguin title.
- Add to Cart and Proceed to Checkout
- You will be prompted to enter your library card number and password (pin)
- Select GET FOR KINDLE
- You will be redirected to the Amazon.com site to get your book
- Choose Get Public Library book
- Sign into Amazon.com if prompted
- Select Download Now to download the file to your computer.
- Save the file to your computer (it's easiest to save to desktop)
- Connect your Kindle to your computer using the USB cord
- Your Kindle will show up as a NEW DEVICE on your computer.
- Open the Documents folder in the Kindle device (from your computer)
- Drag and Drop the Kindle book file from your computer to the Documents folder in the Kindle
- Disconnect the Kindle from your computer
- Open the Kindle – you digital library loan will appear under Documents
